It is with deep distress that I am writing you this letter. The State of Israel cannot allow itself to humiliate Jews, just because of how they practice Judaism. After three and a half years of negotiation, our representatives reached a compromise agreement which would allow All Jews to see the Kotel as “their” holy site, as it being one wall for one people, rather than a synagogue for one kind of Jew. Despite the Government’s approval, implementation has not started.

The State of Israel is very precious to us. This government is risking our faith and trust. This government is undermining the very principles on which it was founded. We must ask, will our children and grandchildren love an Israel that broke faith with their parents, that has not remained true to its ideals? To insure that the Diaspora and Israel remain one people, one family, we call on you to implement the Kotel agreement immediately, without any further delay.
